<b><u>WHITE</u></b>			
<b>Sensale Grillo   Sicily, Italy Organic</b> Named after a delicate Sicilian barbecuing technique, this is light, pretty and floral with ripe stone fruit notes.	£5.50	£6.95	£19.95
<b>Picpoul de Pinet Prestige Foncalieu   VdP d'Oc, France</b> How long can a variety remain trendy? Is trendiness a paradox with time? Does it matter when it is this fresh, balanced and a match made in heaven for seafood? Fetch me a bottle of your finest Pickers!	£5.75	£7.25	£21.00
<b>Mayfly Sauvignon Blanc   Marlborough, New Zealand</b> A propensity for naming their Sauvignon after animals has been well documented in New Zealand and they have conjured up another spurious connection with this wine. Luckily, whilst the marketing department have taken an early lunch, the winemaking team didn't. Great zippy fruit with asparagus notes and a delicious finish.	£5.95	£7.65	£24.00
<b>Luzada Albarino   Rias Baixas, Spain</b> If you've never seen the vines in Rias Baixas then you're missing out on a viticultural treat. The cool sea air means that damp is a real issue for winemakers, so they trellis the vines up high and spread them out overhead to maximise air flow and sun exposure. This cool air isn't all bad- the wines are fantastically mineral driven and fresh	£6.95	£8.95	£26.95
<b>Gavi del Comune di Gavi Nuovo Quadro   Piemonte, Italy Vegan</b> Cortese, the grape and not some underworld Colombian don in hiding, is the star grape here. This is top-notch single estate Gavi that is hand-harvested and spends six months ageing on its lees. White peach and pear with hints of lime and balanced by lovely acidity.	£7.75	£10.25	£29.95
<b>Holden Manz Chenin Blanc   Franschhoek, South Africa</b> Elegant and perfumed with jasmine and peach. This has spent a bit of time in oak so it has some great depth to it along with quince and melon flavours. Perfect with beetroot, goats cheese and smoked fish- not necessarily at the same time though.	£9.50	£12.75	£37.95
<b><u>RED</u></b>			
<b>Cent'Anni Baccolo Appassimento   Veneto, Italy Vegan</b> The Renaissance, the 'floating city', Napoleon's victory in 1797...all faded into insignificance as notable in the history of the Veneto region when this wine was created. The grapes are partially dried to increase flavour. Think of it as a light, baby Amarone with less alcohol and less damage to your bank balance!	£5.50	£6.95	£19.95
<b>Nostros Carmenère   Maipo Valley, Chile Vegan</b> Made by a young and dynamic team, this is intense, almost black, with berries, truffle, paprika and pepper notes. Carmenère was presumed extinct following the phylloxera outbreak in France. Luckily, some was being grown in Chile, having been exported from Bordeaux, although they thought it was Merlot... [wake up] ...this is delicious!	£5.60	£7.50	£22.50
<b>Jaffelin Pinot Noir   VdF, France Vegan</b> Based in the heart of Beaune, Jaffelin are a Burgundy producer with a genius winemaker - Marinette Garnier. This Vin de France is super soft with low tannins and acidity yet has delicious structure and fruit that punches well above its weight thanks to a combination of grapes from Burgundy and the Loire.	£6.65	£8.75	£25.95
<b>Verne Malbec   Mendoza, Argentina Vegan</b> A deep dense blockbuster from 40+ year old vines. Blackberry plum fruit and sweet spice. Silky, warm, juicy and fruity, it is probably impossible to dislike this - go on, have a few bottles and try.	£6.95	£9.50	£27.50

Mirador Reserva 2011 | Rioja, Spain £7.95 £11.25 £42.95

Just like a Christmas episode of Eastenders, you know exactly what you're getting when you have a bottle of Mirador. This Merlot and Cabernet Franc blend is deep red, powerful and complex with cherries, red fruit and a touch of wood.

Holden Manz Visionnaire 2013 | Franschhoek, South Africa £9.50 £12.75 £37.95

A 'Fluid' Bordeaux blend (it's got some Syrah in it) that is absolutely belting, - spice, red fruits, dark fruits, and graphite- this is seriously grown up stuff. Franschhoek always looks misspelt to me.

### **ROSE**

A fantastic Grenache rosé from the South of France. Soft and savoury with just the right amount of spice. £6.70 £8.80 £26.00

### **SPARKLING**

Lunetta Prosecco Spumante White 20cl NV | Veneto, Italy £7.95

Need a little pick-me-up or perhaps the other half will not share a whole bottle with you. I would order half a dozen and show them you're not to be messed with.

Passaparola Prosecco Spumante NV | Veneto, Italy. *Vegan* £24.95

To the tune of Escape (The Piña Colada song) by Rupert Holmes. If you like Pass-a-parola | Having fizz in the sun | Gentle apple and peach flavours | Should be enough just for one...

Autreau Premier Cru Brut NV | Champagne, France £47.00

Ooh la la! Premier Cru sounds rather flash doesn't it? This is a lovely and soft fizz from excellent vineyards and has some nice fruit thanks to it being mainly Pinot Noirs and Meunier.

Joseph Perrier Cuvee Royale Brut NV | Champagne, France £9.50 £55.00

The Grande Marque Champagne house you've never heard of? Keep your LP in the cupboard, take the VC back to the shop, JP is the one you want. Finesse, Style and Sophistication by the bottle-full. Supplied to Queen Victoria and Edward VII, So Cuvee Royale- geddit?
